How to Find CISSM in Van Munching Hall

The School of Public Policy is at the end of Van Munching Hall farthest from the parking garage, while the Business School is at the nearer end. The two parts of the building do not connect above the second floor. If you enter VMH through the doors near the garage, turn right and walk until you see the sign for the School of Public Policy suggesting that you turn left (the last classroom on your left will be 1307). Turn left and walk down a hallway that ends in the School of Public Policy atrium.

The CISSM forum meets in room 1203. CISSM meetings in the Dean's Conference Room are up the stairs in the Administrative Suite, room 2101F. To reach CISSM itself, take the MSPP elevator up to the 4th floor.

Getting to Van Munching Hall by Metro

Take the Green Line to College Park. There is a free shuttle from the Metro Stop to Campus.

Exit the Metro station towards the bus stops. The Shuttle Service to Campus will be labeled University of Maryland. Get off at the third stop (second on-campus stop), directly in front of the **Adele H. Stamp Student Union**. You will be on Campus Drive.

Take Campus Drive north (same direction as the bus is facing) until it winds around and crosses Preinkert Drive. This is about a 10 minute walk. Continue on Campus Drives and you will see a set of stairs to your left leading down a long brick path. Take the steps down toward the large building on your right at the end of the path. This will be Van Munching Hall.

Getting to Van Munching Hall by Car

For GPS, please use the following address: 7621 Mowatt Lane, College Park, MD 20742. You can also use this address (7621 Mowatt Lane, College Park, MD 20742) if you want to print out a map with directions from Google Maps, or if you want to see satellite and street images that Google provides.

Visitor parking is available in the top two levels (5th and 6th floors) of the Mowatt Lane garage. **All visitor spaces are marked with numbers.** Visitors will need to pay for parking upon arrival by entering their parking space number into a kiosk located on the sixth floor near the east and west elevators. Rates are \$3/hour, with a maximum daily rate of \$15 on weekdays and \$5 on weekends. The kiosks accept cash and credit cards (Visa, Master Card & Discover).

From Baltimore and Points North

Take I-95 South to Capital Beltway (I-495). At split, take I-495 West (Exit 27, right lanes) to Silver Spring/Bethesda. Take Exit 28B, New Hampshire Avenue (MD Route 650). Proceed South on New Hampshire Avenue to Adelphi Road (two traffic lights). Turn left on Adelphi Road. Proceed South on Adelphi Road through intersection with University Blvd. (MD Route 193). Make next left at light on Campus Drive. Turn right at circle on Mowatt Lane. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Van Munching Hall is on your left. Turn left into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. **Note: This route takes you past the conventional way to UM to avoid congestion on US Route 1, so ignore signs that say to exit for UM.*

OR,

Take I-95 South to Capital Beltway (I-495). At split, take I-495 West (Exit 27) to Silver Spring/Bethesda and stay in the center right lane to take immediate left exit to College Park, US Route 1. Follow signs and stay right to US Route 1 South, Baltimore Ave. (Exit 25B). Continue on US Route 1 South for more than two miles, passing main entrance to campus. Turn right at light on Guilford Road. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Pass parking garage on right. Turn right into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. Van Munching Hall is on your left. **Note: This is the posted route to UM and easiest to follow, but may take longer due to traffic.*

OR,

Take Baltimore-Washington Parkway (I-295) South to Greenbelt Road (MD Route 193). Follow signs to MD Route 193. Turn left at light off of ramp. Turn right at light on MD Route 193 West. Pass US Route 1 and university entrances to Comcast Center and Byrd

Stadium. Turn left at light on Adelphi Road. Turn left at next light on Campus Drive. Turn right at circle on Mowatt Lane. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Van Munching Hall is on your left. Turn left into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage.

From Montgomery County and Northern Virginia

Take I-66 East or I-270 South to Capital Beltway (I-495). Go East on I-495 to Baltimore/Silver Spring. Take Exit 28B, New Hampshire Avenue (MD Route 650). Proceed South on New Hampshire Avenue to Adelphi Road (two traffic lights). Turn left on Adelphi Road. Proceed south on Adelphi Road through intersection with University Blvd. (MD Route 193). Turn left at next light on Campus Drive. Turn right at circle on Mowatt Lane. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Van Munching Hall is on your left. Turn left into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage.

OR,

Take I-66 East or I-270 South to Capital Beltway (I-495). Go East on I-495 to Baltimore/Silver Spring. Take Exit 25B, US Route 1 South, Baltimore Ave. Continue on US Route 1 South for more than two miles, passing main entrance to campus. Turn right at light on Guilford Road. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Pass parking garage on right. Turn right into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. Van Munching Hall is on your left.

From Washington, D.C.

Take Rhode Island Avenue (US Route 1) North to College Park. Turn left on Guilford Drive. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Pass parking garage on right. Turn right into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. Van Munching Hall is on your left.

OR,

Take New Hampshire Avenue (MD Route 650) or Riggs Road (MD Route 212) to East-West Highway (MD Route 410). Proceed East on East-West Highway to US Route 1. Turn left onto US Route 1. After approximately one mile turn left on Guilford Drive. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Pass parking garage on right. Turn right into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. Van Munching Hall is on your left.

OR,

Take New York Avenue (US Route 50) East to Baltimore-Washington Parkway (I-295). Take East-West Highway (MD Route 410) Hyattsville/New Carrollton exit. Turn left (West) at traffic light on East-West Highway, MD Route 410. Turn right on US Route 1 North. After approximately one mile turn left on Guilford Drive. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Pass parking garage on right. Turn right into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. Van Munching Hall is on your left.

From Annapolis and Points East

Take Rt. 50 West to Capital Beltway (I-495). Go North/West on I-495 to Exit 28B, New Hampshire Avenue (MD Route 650). Proceed South on New Hampshire Avenue to

Adelphi Road (two traffic lights). Turn left on Adelphi Road. Proceed South on Adelphi Road through intersection with University Blvd. (MD Route 193). Make next left at light on Campus Drive. Turn right at circle on Mowatt Lane. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Van Munching Hall is on your left. Turn left into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. **Note: This route takes you past the conventional way to UM to avoid congestion on US Route 1, so ignore signs that say to exit for UM.*

OR,

Take Rt. 50 West to Capital Beltway (I-495). Go North/West on I-495 to Exit 25 US Route 1. Turn left at light on US Route 1 South to College Park. Continue on US Route 1 for more than two miles, passing main entrance to campus. Turn right at light on Guilford Road. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Pass parking garage on right. Turn right into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. Van Munching Hall is on your left. **Note: This is the posted route to UM and easiest to follow, but may take longer due to traffic.*

OR,

Take Rt. 50 West to Capital Beltway (I-495). Go North/West on I-495 to Exit 23 Kenilworth Ave (MD Route 201). Take MD Route 201 South to Bladensburg. Take Greenbelt Road (MD Route 193) exit and turn right at light on MD Route 193 West. Pass US Route 1 and university entrances to Comcast Center and Byrd Stadium. Turn left at light on Adelphi Road. Turn left at next light on Campus Drive. Turn right at circle on Mowatt Lane. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Van Munching Hall is on your left. Turn left into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage.

From Springfield, Virginia, and Points South

Take I-495/I-95 North to Exit 28B, New Hampshire Avenue (MD Route 650). Proceed South on New Hampshire Avenue to Adelphi Road (two traffic lights). Turn left on Adelphi Road. Proceed South on Adelphi Road through intersection with University Blvd. (MD Route 193). Make next left at light on Campus Drive. Turn right at circle on Mowatt Lane. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Van Munching Hall is on your left. Turn left into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. **Note: This route takes you past the conventional way to UM to avoid congestion on US Route 1, so ignore signs that say to exit for UM.*

OR,

Take I-495/I-95 North to Exit 25 US Route 1 South, Baltimore Ave. Continue on US Route 1 South for more than two miles, passing main entrance to campus. Turn right at light on Guilford Road. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Pass parking garage on right. Turn right into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage. Van Munching Hall is on your left. **Note: This is the posted route to UM and easiest to follow, but may take longer due to traffic.*

OR,

Take I-495/I-95 North to Exit 23 Kenilworth Ave (MD Route 201). Take MD Route 201 South to Bladensburg. Take Greenbelt Road (MD Route 193) exit and turn right at light on MD Route 193 west. Pass US Route 1 and university entrances to Comcast Center and Byrd Stadium. Turn left at light on Adelphi Road. Turn left at next light on Campus

Drive. Turn right at circle on Mowatt Lane. Follow signs to Visitor Parking. Van Munching Hall is on your left. Turn left into Mowatt Lane Parking Garage.
